CHRISTMAS STOCKING DIRECTIONS OPERATION SHOEBOX 8360 East Highway 25 Belleview, Florida 34420

Fabrics: cotton, cotton-poly blends, lightweight flannel or corduroy. Use a contrasting fabric to cut a stocking cuff measuring 4" by 15 1/2".

REMEMBER: Online pattern must be enlarged.

STITCH ALL SEAMS 1/4" WIDE

- 1. Place right sides of stocking together & stitch the front seam (the toe side), down from the top approximately 4". Open flat & press seam to one side.
- 2. With stocking flat, right side facing up, place 1 long side of the cuff, right side facing down, along top edge of stocking body & stitch the cuff to the stocking top. The cuff is not folded down over the body of the stocking. It remains above it.
- 3. On each side edge of the cuff, fold in ¼" toward the wrong side of the fabric & stitch 2" down the side to create a finished edge for the casing.
- 4. Fold top edge of the cuff down 1" toward wrong side of fabric & stitch across, backstitching @ the beginning & end, creating a 1" casing for the drawstring. Clip the ¼" seam just below the casing on each side, so the seam will lay flat for step 5.
- 5. Fold right sides of stocking & cuff together & stitch starting just below the casing making sure to backstitch,@ the beginning, & ending where you first stitched down the 4" @ front of stocking. Clip curves & turn stocking right side out.

The string is made of 4 ply worsted yarn, single crochet, 26" long. We have a team to string the stockings if you prefer to skip this step.
